### **Claire Heffernan**

Principal Investigator, UKRI GCRF Action  
Against Stunting Hub



Claire Heffernan's work at LIDC focuses on facilitating interdisciplinary research across seven University of London institutions that addresses critical challenges in international development. Claire's particular areas of expertise include the application of interdisciplinary research within the development sphere in addition to the emerging paradigm of solutions-based research. Her research interests range from the impacts of climate change on food security, nutrition and health, to the behavioural drivers of resilience and adaptation, to the rise in antimicrobial resistance across the Global South.

Claire is the Principal Investigator of the UKRI GCRF Action Against Stunting Hub and will be responsible for delivering the overall deliverables of the Hub in partnership with the Co-PI and Central Hub team. Claire will also lead the work on the Citizen Science component of the Hub.
